



A Leadership Training Program

The Development School for Youth (DSY) is a two-month leadership training and career education program for young people between the ages of 16 and 21. Business professionals participate in the program and create the school in partnership with the students and the Program Directors.

The centerpiece of the DSY is a commitment to developmental learning. Using an innovative performance-based learning approach, the Development School provides young adults with a forum where they can challenge their assumptions about who they are and how they can be in the world. Young adults create new performances of themselves that help them successfully negotiate the business environment and interact with adults on a professional level. Students are supported to develop as leaders by giving performances they have never given before.

The DSY's leadership training is organized as a series of weekly workshops, led by senior executives who partner with the program, introducing students to the worlds of finance, advertising, accounting, law and other leading industries. Students also learn public speaking, how to dress for success, how to write a resume and how to interview for a job. All of the students who graduate from the program are placed in paid full time summer internships provided by sponsoring companies.

The program meets once a week from 4:15 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Participants are expected to attend all workshops.
