The All Stars Project, Inc. (ASP) is a non-partisan, non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to promoting human development through the use of an innovative performance-based model. The ASP creates outside of school, educational and performing arts activities for thousands of poor and minority young people. It sponsors community and experimental theatre, develops leadership training and pursues volunteer initiatives that build and strengthen communities.

The All Stars Project youth programs are not remedial learning programs. All Stars programs focus on the social, cultural and creative development of young people. Performatory approaches – play, improvisation and performance – are critical tools for youth development. Performance supports young people to actively create new ways of how to be in the world.

The All Stars Projects four youth programs are:

Production of Youth By Youth, is a program for young people between the ages of 16 and 21 who want to explore what it means to be a cultural producer. Applicants will be asked to write a short essay discussing what they think a producer is.

Youth Onstage! is the youth theatre of the All Stars Project for young people between the ages of 14 and 21. Applicants will be asked to audition with two memorized monologues, one dramatic and one comic.

Development School for Youth is a leadership training program for young people between the ages of 16 and 21. Applicants will be asked to write a short essay discussing what they think a leader is.

All Stars Talent Show Network is a program that involves young people between the ages of 5 and 25 in producing and performing in talent shows in neighborhood school auditoriums.

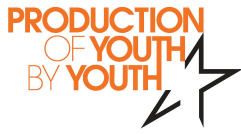

The Production of Youth by Youth (PYBY) is a program for young people between the ages of 16 and 21 who want to explore what it means to be a cultural producer. Using the city as its campus, PYBY's weekly Tuesday workshops expose its participants to the world of cultural production, bringing them behind the scenes to learn how theater, television, music and the graphic arts are produced and distributed. Graduates of PYBY are placed in unpaid summer internships in a wide variety of cultural organizations.

The Youth Onstage! Community Performance School (YO!) is a performance training program for young people between the ages of 14 and 21. At YO!, professional theatre artists and teachers, along with community activists, teach classes and lead workshops for young people interested in developing into politically-engaged theatre people. The workshops take place on Wednesday afternoons and Saturday mornings during the school year, and four days a week during the Summer semester. After completing the school, graduates are invited to join the Youth Onstage! The Development School for Youth (DSY) is a four-month leadership training program for young people between the ages of 16 and 21. The DSY is organized as a series of weekly workshops, that take place on either Tuesday or Wednesday and are led by senior executives who partner with the program. These workshops introduce students to the worlds of finance, advertising, accounting, law and other leading industries. Students also learn public speaking, how to dress for success, how to write a resume and how to interview for a job. The All Stars Talent Show Network (ASTSN) is an after-school, performance-based enrichment program for inner-city youth. Each year, thousands of children and young adults, ages 5 to 25, participate in auditions, performance workshops and talent shows that take place in local school auditoriums and at the All Stars Project headquarters on 42nd Street.
